

CONSTITUTION OF THE CENTRAL VIRGINIA REGION, CADILLAC-LASALLE CLUB

- **ARTICLE I - NAME AND PURPOSE**

- Section 1 - NAME: The name of the Club shall be CENTRAL VIRGINIA REGION, CADILLAC-LASALLE CLUB.
- Section 2 - PURPOSES: The purposes for which the Club is founded are:
 - for the development, publication and exchange of information pertaining to recognized Cadillac and LaSalle automobiles;
 - to encourage the maintenance, preservation and restoration of all recognized Cadillac and LaSalle automobiles;
 - to maintain references on recognized Cadillac and LaSalle automobiles; and
 - to promote social fellowship among the Club members.

The Central Virginia Region, Cadillac-LaSalle Club does not represent the political, religious or other non-automotive related views or biases of one or more members in any way.

- **ARTICLE III - DUES**

- Section 1-DUES: Dues for the Club members shall be established by the Board of Directors. The annual dues of the Club members are due in the month of July.

- **ARTICLE IV - DIRECTORS**

- Section I-NUMBER: The Board of Directors of the Club shall consist of The Club officers. Past Presidents, when Club members in good standing, shall be members of the Board ex officio with voting rights.
- ~~Corresponding Secretary - The Corresponding Secretary shall record all minutes of meetings of the Board of Directors and the monthly meeting of the members. They shall perform such other duties as the Constitution or Bylaws prescribe or as the President may direct.~~

- **ARTICLE VI - CLUB MANAGEMENT**

- Section 1-ORDER OF BUSINESS: Robert's Rules of Order-Revised shall govern this Club in all cases where applicable and where they are not in conflict with the Club constitution.

- **ARTICLE VI - USE OF MEMBERSHIP ROSTER**

The membership roster, or any list of members, shall not be used by, or released to any individual or business, for any purpose without a majority vote of the Board of Directors for such use at a regularly called meeting, having been published as a pre-designated item for the agenda and included with a notice of the meeting as required in the Constitution, Article VI, Section 3.

- **ARTICLE VIII - DECORUM**

No member acting in a Club capacity shall conduct himself in such a way as to bring opprobrium on the Club or its members, or impugn the Club, its members or other individuals in Club-sponsored communications, car show displays or car show-related events.
